Background (10 mins)

The West Side Neighborhood Association (WSNA or Association) is an organization consisting of citizens dedicated to the improvement of the West Side neighborhood of Cumberland, MD. The Association will sponsor and foster a variety of educational, beautification, and improvement programs and activities designed to enhance the quality of life in the West Side. Our goal is to organize a dedicated core group of volunteers that can help to formally incorporate as a non-profit organization to facilitate fundraising and grant opportunities to further our organizational goals.

To that end, the Association will have no substantial part in the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Association shall not participate in, or intervene in any political campaign of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

The specific objectives and purpose of the Association shall be:

- a) To create understanding and cooperation between and among citizens, public officials, and municipal employees through increased communication and community activity.
- b) To promote community cooperation, participation, and events.



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
- c) To assist in crime prevention and overall public safety through the dissemination of information and creation of community programs.
- d) To consult with residents, property owners, business owners, and public officials regarding public safety, sanitation, housing, community development, youth programs, transportation, and public works.
- e) To educate and inform West Side residents, property owners, and business owners and work with all relevant public officials and municipal agencies to address laws, issues, and interests applicable to them.

We hope to be able to organize our work into smaller committees:

- Beautification (Clean ups, community gardens, code enforcement, etc.)
- Economic Development & Public Policy (Businesses, local government relations, etc.)
- Safety (Crime prevention, law enforcement relations, etc.)
- Social (Community events, family activities, happy hours, etc.)
- Education (Board of Education, local schools, resources for students, etc.)

Neighborhood Boundaries (10 mins)


The City of Cumberland Neighborhood Advisory Commission creates and maintains neighborhood maps (<u>http://www.ci.cumberland.md.us/337/Neighborhood-Maps</u>). The City's current "Westside" map does not represent what most residents consider the neighborhood:





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We propose that this organization's boundaries include these areas and are seeking your feedback. This map proposes that our eastern boundary be the Potomac River and Wills Creek. The southern boundary would include the entirety of Kelly Road, Brown Ave, and Dent Lane. The western boundary would include the entirety of Windsor Road, Camden Avenue, and Woodland Drive. The northern boundary would include the entirety of Wills Creek Ave, Sedgwick Street, and Mt. View Drive.

- **Code Enforcement:** The City of Cumberland Department of Community Development began neighborhood nuisance sweeps in the City starting on August 28th.
 - \circ $\;$ They will visit every single house in the City over the next few months.
 - Notice of violation or a "thank you" will be issued based on your property status.



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- Nuisance code violations include dwellings, yards, and lots to be kept clean from the sidewalk to the rear of the property; cutting the weeds; propagation of ornamental grasses and bamboo; removal or trimming of trees, vegetations, etc.; and noise pollution.
- If you receive a notice of violation, you will have 7-10 days to resolve the violation. If it has not been resolved upon their return, a formal notice will be issued.
- The owner of a property with no violations will be entered in a drawing for a prize following the completion of inspections on the street. The City will notify the winner for each sweep as it concludes.
